

Discussion Forum Guidelines

What is a Discussion Forum?

Discussion forum is a part of collaborative learning methodology. Students are offered a topic in a form a problem statement and they are expected to express their opinions pertaining to the topic. This discussion happens in textual format wherein students can share their views on given topic. Through typing the text the students can post their views on every discussion forum topic through their LMS.

The student needs to participate in the following two types of discussion forums:

1. **Open Discussion Forum**
2. **Graded Discussion Forum**

Open Discussion Forum	Graded Discussion Forum
Open Discussion Forums do not contribute to Internal Assessments. They are purely for a collaborative learning purpose. They are non-graded discussion forums. (No Marks)	Graded Discussion Forum has a part of Internal Assessments, and it also contributes for 5 marks of the total scores.
This is a unit-level activity . Every unit of the respective subject will have a non-graded discussion forum. (No Marks)	This is a subject-level assessment . Every subject will have a graded discussion forum under Assignments tab on LMS .
Schedule of this type of discussion forum is published on the university website along with Live Lecture Calendar.	Graded Discussion Forums are published on the LMS under Assignments tab . Email notification of the same will be sent to the students once the graded discussion forum topics are published.

Do's and Don'ts for Discussion Forums

- Kindly read the topic carefully along with the comments or opinions expressed by others before posting your comment on the discussion forum.
- Please keep your answers or opinion short and to the point. Misleading or inappropriate responses will not be considered.
- Respect the opinions of others whether or not you agree with them.
- Keep your language sober, sophisticated, and politically correct. Avoid slangs.
- Please avoid use of any foul or unacceptable words.
- Ensure to write in a grammatically correct language to avoid any misleading connotations or wrong inferences.

- Do not resort to making any sort of biased statements. Especially avoid making any statements that may hurt anybody's religious or political beliefs. This is strictly prohibited.
- Most importantly, the university reserves all the rights of moderation and in case of any objectionable or inappropriate content is found, the same will be deleted and disciplinary action will be initiated against such learners.

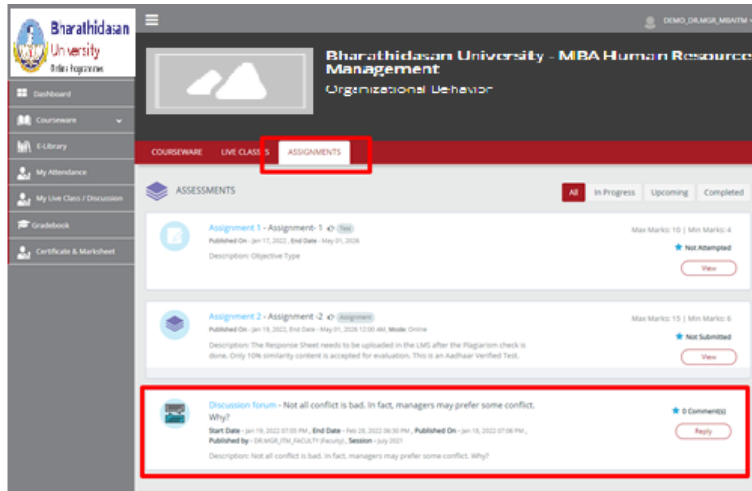

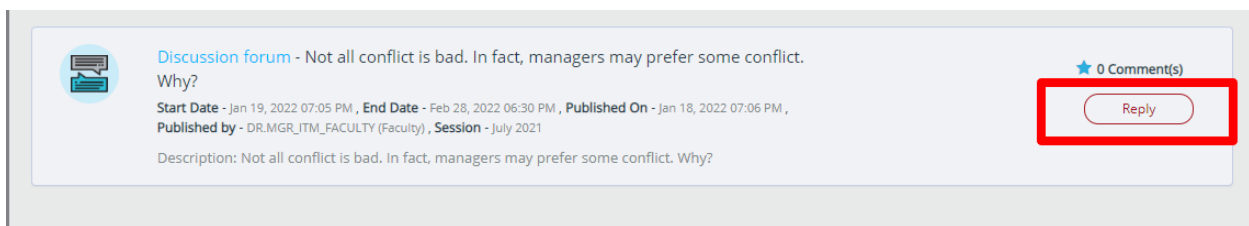

About Graded Discussion Forum:

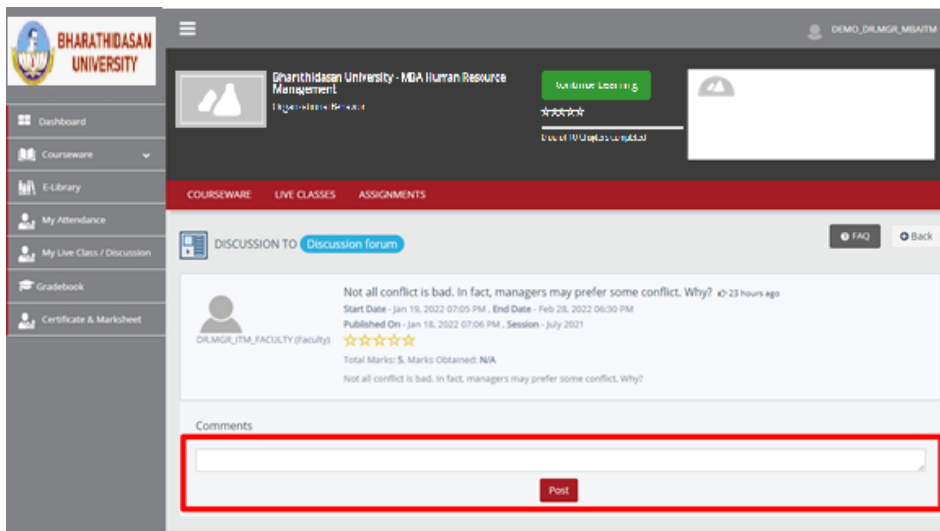
